

REGULATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTION OF STIPENDS, FREE AND HALF FREE STUDENTSHIPS, INSTALLMENT(S) OF FEE AND FEE DEFERMENT

Whereas it is expedient to frame the Ghazi University, Dera Ghazi Khan, Institution of Stipends, Free and Half Free Studentships, Installment(s) of Fee and Fee Deferment Regulations, on the recommendations of the Academic Council, the Syndicate in exercise of the powers vested in it under Section 32(1)(x) approves the “Ghazi University, Dera Ghazi Khan, Institution of Stipends, Free and Half Free Studentships, Installment(s) of Fee and Fee Deferment Regulations” 2021.

1. Short Title and Commencement:

- (a) These Regulations may be called “The Ghazi University, Dera Ghazi Khan Institution of Stipends, Free and Half Free Studentships, Installment(s) of Fee and Fee Deferment Regulations,2021.
- (b) They shall come into force with immediate effect after approval of the Syndicate.

2. Definitions:

- (a) “Act” means the Ghazi University, Dera Ghazi Khan Act, 2012.
 - (b) “Academic Council” means the Academic Council of the University.
 - (c) “Free Studentship” means full fee concession in the Tuition Fee for a particular period.
 - (d) “Half Free Studentship” means half fee concession in Tuition Fee for a particular period.
 - (e) “Committee” means the Committee constituted under these Regulations.
 - (f) “Stipend” means a special monthly grant made to the student for a particular period.
 - (g) “Syndicate” means the Syndicate of the University.
 - (h) “Vice Chancellor” means the Vice Chancellor of the University.
 - (j) “Students” mean students of the University.
3. Any expression used but not defined in the Regulations shall have the same meaning as is assigned to it in the Act.

REGULATIONS:

- (c) The students who are unable to pay fee during their studies may apply to the Vice Chancellor for the grant of Stipend or Free and Half-Free Studentship and Installment(s) of Fee and Fee Deferment.
 1. The applications of such students must have the endorsement of their father/guardian. Only the talented students with poor means will be eligible to apply for these concessions.
 2. The Vice Chancellor shall appoint a Committee to consider the requests of the students who applied for the grant of Stipends, Free and Half-Free Studentships, Installment(s) of Fee and Fee Deferment.
 3. The Vice Chancellor shall refer the applications to the Committee, which shall consider the requests, keeping in view the financial position, merit of performance in studies and general conduct of the students and may recommend any one of the followings: -
 - (a) A monthly Stipend of Rs.1500/- per month for an academic year (excluding summer session). He will pay University fee regularly.
 - (b) Free Studentship for an Academic Year (excluding summer session)
 - (c) Half Free Studentship for an Academic Year (excluding summer session)
 - (d) Two to three installments of fee.

(e) Fee deferment for a particular period.

Only the tuition fee will be exempted while awarding Free and Half Free Studentships.

The total number of students in a degree course for Stipends, Free and Half Free concession should not exceed 10 students. A student will be eligible only one concession at a time.

4. The recommendations of the Committee duly approved by the Vice Chancellor being competent authority shall be notified by the Treasurer.
5. The Treasurer's office shall maintain a separate record of the students who got Stipends, Free/ Half Free Studentship and installments and deferment of fee.
6. The office of the Treasurer shall ensure that till the completion of the semester, the dues from the students who got installments and deferment in fee are recovered.
7. In case the students do not pay the dues up to the completion of the semester, their enrolment for the next semester may not be made.
8. An undertaking from the students who got installments and fee deferment may be taken that they shall pay the fee up to the period fixed by the University.
9. The Stipends and Free/Half Free studentships will be awarded with the express understanding that the recipient will attend the classes regularly and pursue his/her studies industriously. Should it appear at any time that the scholar has been irregular in attendance or has failed to make satisfactory progress in studies or has been involved in in any activity which is unbecoming of a student, the Stipend, Half Free and Free Studentship shall be withdrawn and he/she will not be eligible for any of the concessions indicated in Regulation No.3 during the whole period of the study in the University.
10. An undertaking by the student duly signed by the father/guardian on Judicial Paper of Rs.50/- shall be taken before the award of Stipend or Free/Half Free Studentship indicating that in case of his/her unsatisfactory performance or his involvement in any activity which is considered prejudicial to the good order of the University he/she will be liable to refund all the financial benefits unconditionally and shall not be eligible for any of the concessions indicated in Regulation No. 3 during the period of his study in the University.
